TRAVEL FELLOWSHIP FOR THE VISUAL ARTS

Applications for the fellowship must include the following:

- **Brief Biography:**
Tell us about yourself.
- **Statement of Intent:**
Describe your travel plans and tell us how they are related to your art practice.
- **Budget:** The price of tickets, lodging, etc.
- **Examples of Work:**
Provide examples of your art in electronic form (digital files or web links).
- **Official Transcript:**
Submit your Yale transcript.
- **Recommendations:**
Submit two letters of recommendation from members of the Yale faculty.

The Mary Hotchkiss Williams Travel Fellowship for the Visual Arts, awarded by the Yale University Art Gallery, supports travel abroad for qualified Yale undergraduates engaged in making visual art. This year, up to five fellowships will be awarded to students who demonstrate superior performance in their respective fields of artistic practice and present a proposal for travel that will provide enriching experiences to the developing artist. The fellowship carries a grant of \$5,500. This fellowship is open to all Yale undergraduates. Preference is given to studio-art majors but students majoring in other fields are invited to apply.
